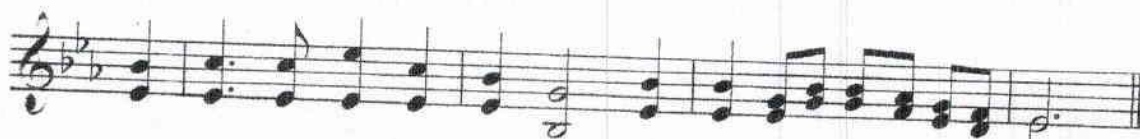
1. Praise waits for thee in Zi - on; all men shall wor - ship there
