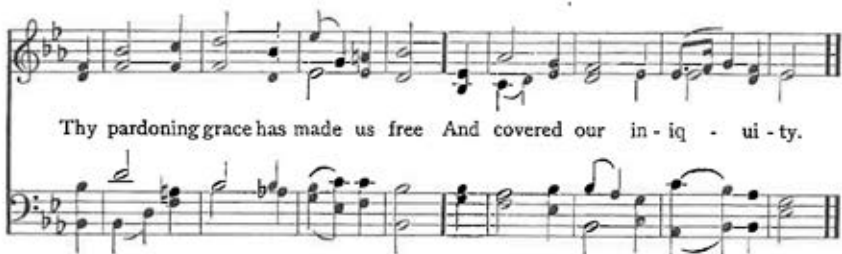
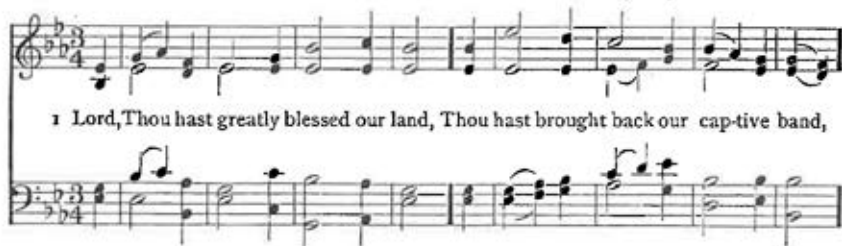


PSALM 85 L. M.
